Minutes from PTA General Board Meeting, October 16, 2012

Call to order: Nicki Foran and Tracy Heins, Co – Presidents

- Approval of May 2012 Meetings minutes
- Vote on Standing Rules and Regulations we must follow-passed
- Washington State PTA Legislative Assembly results for Sunrise:
 - Highly qualified teachers
 - o Fund Education First
 - \circ Complete Solution for K 12 funding
 - o Struggling readers
 - Advance Basic Education Reforms
- Discussed how to spend approximately \$2000 that was over budgeted for the science program. Ideas included:
 - o Fix/upgrade playground
 - o Track and long jump area cleaned up
 - o New wood chips in playground area, old ones removed
 - Principal Hale will check into this to see if the district provides wood chips
 - o Community clean up for school
 - Mrs. Watson's class looking for community service project

Treasurer's Update: Phil Lucido

- September figures include:
 - \$3500 received from Membership, \$2400 of that paid to local North Shore PTA
 - o \$6557 income from Employee Matching
 - o \$453 from Pass the Hat so far
 - o Fall Fiesta broke even (not a fundraiser)
 - \$25,000 grant for science teacher (expense), budget is set at \$30,000
 - \$2500 raised a couple of years ago at target science fundraiser
 - Are over budget by \$2520, will put this toward the following:
 - Golden Acorn/Apple budget increased from \$150 to \$300
 - Teacher appreciation budget increased from \$250 to \$400
 - State Convention budget increased from \$200 to \$400
 - Hospitality budget increased from \$150 to \$350

Fundraising Update: Lindsay Rogers, Jen Guadagno

- Annual Fund drive has started
- Employee Match with Microsoft:
 - o Membership fees are matchable
 - O Will match 10+ hours a year at \$17 an hour
 - Volunteer hours must be for PTA sponsored time, not classroom time (Art docent may qualify)

 - o 30 youth volunteers and lots of adult volunteers

 - o Cake walk too crazy with kids running around
 - Not enough cakes
 - Communication on how the cake walk works and cake contest not clear
- Teacher Appreciation lunch going well, next date set for November 15, hosted by third graders
- Halloween dance October 19th
 - o Dance instruction starts Oct. 15-18 with Galen
 - o Tickets on sale before and after school and at the door
 - Can wear a school appropriate costume

 - o Big changes coming over the next 2 -3 years
 - Annual Measurable Objectives know measures the school against itself in 45 potential cells
 - MSP used for the next 2 years
 - Sunrise had second highest score in reading and math in the North Shore School District in 2011
 - Did not make goals for 2012
 - School Improvement goals:
 - Reading and math are goals, try to get standard kids to above standard
 - Teachers have goals, plans and a way to measure it
 - School Challenges
 - Small school with high special education population
 - Already high test scores
